fontinst – utility to run TeX as fontinst

**SYNOPSIS**

**fontinst** *package*

**DESCRIPTION**

**fontinst** runs **tex**(1) with the **--prognam**e flag set to pretend to be the program fontinst (affecting Karl Berry paths).

Typing

```
fontinst fontinst.sty
```

will start **tex**(1) and give the user an interactive prompt (\*) where fontinst commands can be typed (such as `\latinfamily{ptm}{ }\bye`).
